- ►Three Key Features:
  - 1. Water quality emphasis
  - 2. Nonpoint sources non-regulatory
  - 3. Voluntary participation

#### Watershed Planning Process

#### ► Six Steps

- 1. Building partnerships
- 2. Characterizing the watershed
- Management goals, practices, measures, actions
- 4. Design implementation program
- 5. Implement the Watershed Management Plan
- 6. Measure progress adaptive management

# Benefits of a Watershed Management Plan

- ► Holistic WS assessment identifying areas with greatest ROI
- ▶ Document/demonstrate conservation doesn't cost; it pays
  - ► Increased landowner profitability
  - ▶ Improved soil health

  - ► Increased recreational opportunities
